Additional items discussed and Kay will get additional information on the following:

- Deadline to proceed/decline Home Grant Contract.
- Whether it is appropriate to send letter with tear sheet to grant consultants or builders
- Environmental Clearance document & lead paint test document.
- If City declines grant money affect future grants
- RE confirm selection/order of rehabs/reconstructs. Must write explanation how decision was made to proceed and why one house over another. – reason.

- Lucy letter requesting reduction in match and extension in grant contract. May affect point system and make affect City eligibility.
- When Grant is 50% complete, matching funds should be in place
- Use only forms provided by the State
- 2-4 persons required to administrate documents, which are done online.
- Check with Steve Rinehart about inspections
- \$40,000 plus will require 4-5 inspections during process
- Excess funds not used can be used on other home not in excess of \$55,000. i.e., infrastructure – water lines
- Importance of interim and final lien waivers.
- Understanding that the Home Program is a Reimbursement Program.
- Citizens cannot stay in their homes while under construction.
- Homeowner's Insurance
- Check with TML if City insures what contractor insurance does not.
- Lists of Administrators and Builders must be reviewed by State
- Specs must be written by City and provided to each prospective builder to include standards and "new" Model Energy Code – see website
- Rehab/Reconstruct must have same # rooms or more
